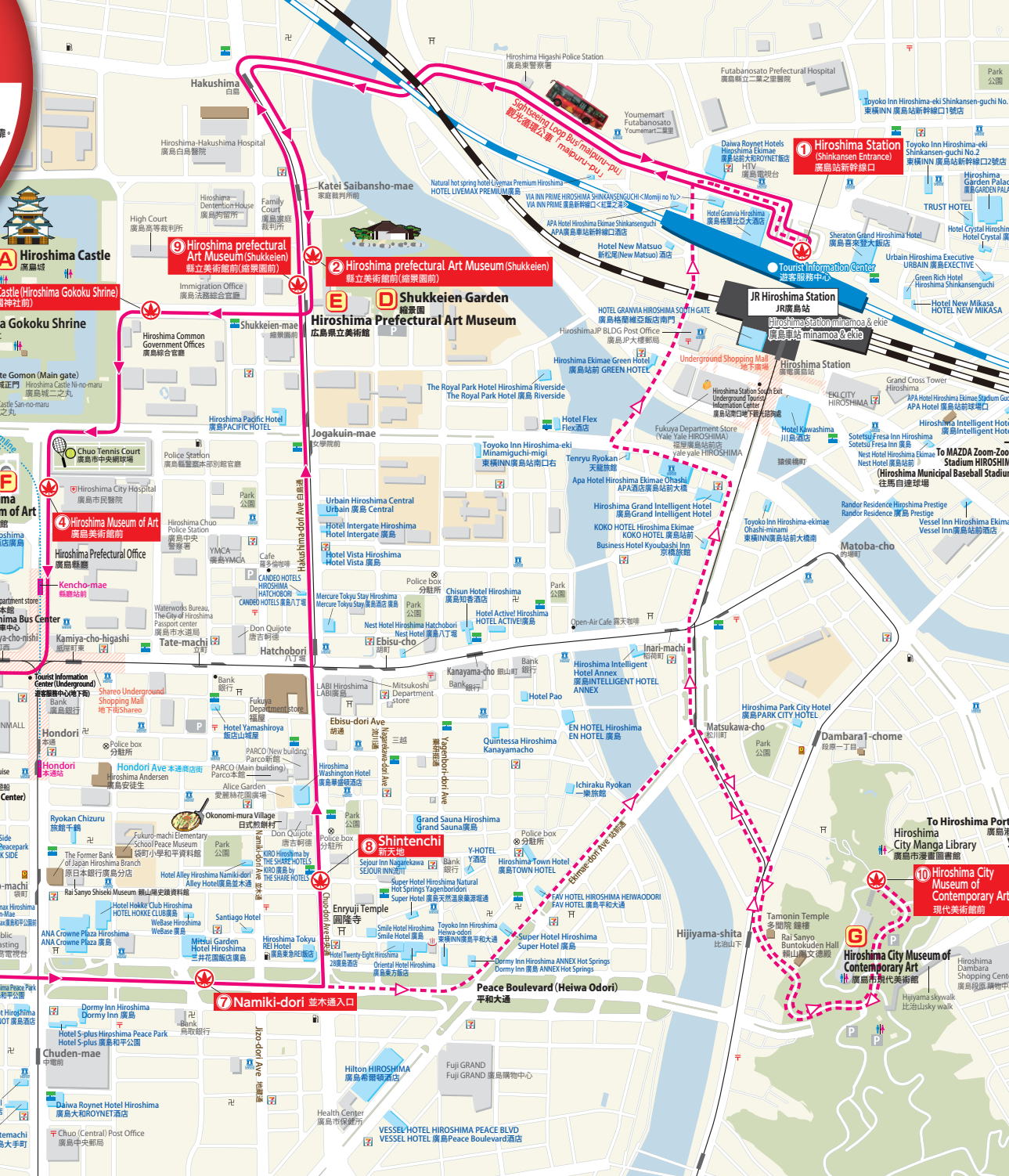


"Hiroshima Meipuru~pu" Route map 觀光地圖

Major Tourist Spots 觀光景點介紹

A Hiroshima Castle 廣島城

Construction of the castle began in 1589 by Mori Terumoto, and it later became the residence of the Fukushima and Asano clans. The main keep was destroyed by the atomic bomb and rebuilt in 1958. Although the interior of the keep was closed to the public in 2026, the exterior of the keep can still be viewed, and the reconstructed buildings of the second bailey can also be visited.

B The A-Bomb Dome 原子彈爆炸遺址

The A-Bomb Dome was called the Hiroshima prefecture industrial Promotion Hall, before it was destroyed by the atomic bomb. The A-Bomb Dome was registered on the UNESCO World Heritage List in 1996.

C Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum 廣島和平紀念資料館

Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum was established in August, 1955 to show the effects of the atomic bomb and to promote world peace. The museum uses artifacts from the bombing and historic records to describe the effects and aftermath of the atomic bomb.

資料館於1955年8月開館，目的在於向全世界傳達核戰爭所帶來的慘狀，與廣島市民和國際社會永久和平的願望。館內展示了核戰爭的慘狀，同時也介紹了廣島市民在原子彈爆炸後的復健和後裔的發現與研究。

D Shukkeien Garden 縮景園

The Garden was created by Nagasena Asano, the Daimyo of Hiroshima, for his villa in 1620. The present style of the garden is a product of extensive renovation in 1783. The garden was designated as a National Garden in 1940.

縮景園是由廣島藩主淺野長政於1620年作為別墅的庭園而興建。1783年的「天明大改修」，大改修了庭園的景觀。並在1940年指定為國家名園。

E Hiroshima Prefectural Art Museum 廣島縣立美術館

The museum houses more than 5,200 works of art. This collection has pieces relating to Hiroshima prefecture, Asia and the 1920s-30s. The works of art on display change four times a year.

F Hiroshima Museum of Art 廣島美術館

The museum's permanent exhibition has 90 works of modern art. These include paintings by Claude Monet, Pierre-Auguste Renoir, Vincent Van Gogh, as well as modern and traditional Japanese style paintings. The museum also holds special exhibitions 5-6 times a year.

G Hiroshima City Museum of Contemporary Art 廣島市現代美術館

The museum was designed by the renowned architect Kisho Kurokawa and is situated in Hijiya Park. In the museum grounds, there are works of modern art by artists such as Henry Moore. The museum houses a diverse collection of contemporary art from around the world.
